



## **Regulations for Justices of the Peace**

The Justice of the Peace Regulations, 2015, set out the Code of Conduct for Justices of the Peace in the Cayman Islands.

Justices of the Peace are required to keep a written record of all signatures witnessed, land transfers witnessed and all warrants issued. A record will also need to be kept of all occasions on which Justice of the Peace services are refused and reasons are to be recorded.

Justices of the Peace who wish to continue to undertake the duties of this Office are required to submit their Counter Records to the Clerk of the Court on an annual basis, as required by Law. All Justices of the Peace are invited to submit all their outstanding Counter Records to the Clerk of Court, **no later than 31<sup>st</sup> January 2021**, and subsequent Counter Records, 31<sup>st</sup> December of each year.
