GRAND COURT PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 2/97

Register of Judgments and Register of Writs, etc.

(GCR 0.63, rr.7 and 8)

- 1. GCR Order 63, rr.7 and 8 provide for the establishment of a register of judgments containing an office copy of every final judgment made or treated as having been made in open court and a register of writs and other originating process containing office copies of every writ, originating summons, originating motion or petition issued by the court. These registers are open to public inspection upon payment of the prescribed fees.
- 2. The registers were created on 1st June, 1995 and contain office copies of judgments given and originating process issued only after that date.
- 3. Any person wishing to obtain a copy of any judgment given in open court or any originating process issued prior to 1st June, 1995 should make application by letter addressed to the Clerk of the Court. Such application should specify the full title and cause number of the action in question. The Clerk of the Court will then arrange for copies to be obtained from the relevant court files as soon thereafter as is reasonably possible.
